Clerks Financial Report:

The financial report for the end of year:

- Current Account - £709.89; Earmarked Reserve Account - £6055.48
- Payments approved: Broadband £70, School fees £15, Ink jets, postage etc. £40.86

Planning Applications:

- 7 Tetbury Lane – Approved.
- Plans for small extension to 8 Boxwell Road – No objections.
- Food bin and extension at Whitewater Farm – No objections.

Roads:

- Ongoing issues regarding pot holes on Back Lane, Chapel Lane and Whitewater Road - GCC to be advised.

Other Matters arising:

- Councilor Morgan gave CDC update: Council tax rise has been frozen for the third year and Green bin charges will also remain the same. Car parking charges at CDC car parks across the district would continue to offer free parking after 3pm. Recycling in the district is 59.6% - it is one of the best performing in the country.
- Lottery funding has now been secured for a village defibrillator – to be located in the village telephone box.
- There will be a working party to tidy up the cemetery in preparation for Anzac Day. This will take place on various dates between now and the 22nd April (weather dependent) – painting railings, strimming verge, replacing posts.
- Royal Oak Pub – discussed safety for motorists and pedestrians regarding the wall and overhanging trees along Tetbury Lane and at the cross road.
